1. MODES

2.1	User modes Manual: Timer: ON/OFF:	The system has 4 modes of operation all zones are off until turned on individually all zones are controlled via the time clock all zones are switched on or off simultaneously		
2.2	Selecting a mod	Press until the correct mode is indicated on screen. Mode selected also indicated by the LEDs on the console.		
2.3	Zone Control Heating and domestic hot water are controlled through zones. A zone is a room or area which is to be heated independently. Turning a zone ON or OFF enter the zone number and press key.			


2. <u>ROOM SETTING FROM THE CONSOLE</u>


Each zone can be controlled via the Console remotely. On the Console enter the zone number







5. **DOMESTIC HOT WATER**

4.1 Hot Water Control

Hot Water is controlled via it's Zone number (Normally Zone 32) Hot water is timed as a zone [e.g. zone 32] and can also be switched on/off like a zone **NOTE**: HEATING OFF does not affect the domestic hot water.

4.2 Hot Water Boost

To turn on/off domestic **hot water boost** press _____ The HW key turns the Immersion on for 2 Hours.

NOTE: To return to the display to normal operation from any function at any time just press



6. <u>Thermostats</u>

The Thermostat is very easy to use: Normally the Thermostat indicates in large digits the current temperature and the set point temperature (SP).

Temperature Settings



To change the set pointSPPress - or + to increase or decrease the desired
temperatureTo change the set backSBPress - or + to illuminate the display
Press Power Button until SB is displayed


